Thank you for your enquiry regarding Membership.

The enclosed information may be varied by the Management Council at its discretion and is intended to provide a brief overview of the Club, costs and waiting time.

Puttenham Golf Club is a private Members' Club. It has standards of behaviour, etiquette and dress which have been set in order to create an atmosphere of conviviality, relaxation and friendliness. It is important to understand these standards and therefore what is expected of each and every member who joins this Club.

It is a condition of joining for Junior members up to age 18, that they are assessed by the Club Professional within the Junior Academy system. This will ensure that new juniors are fully conversant with the etiquette and rules of the game prior to entering competitions, etc. Fees for the Junior Academy are separate from Club subscription and entrance fees and full details of these may be obtained from the Club Professional.

The Junior Organiser runs a variety of informal and more formal competitions specifically for Junior members (up to age 18) in the form of Sunday roll ups and get togethers over the school holidays. Once a Junior member attains adult handicap status they become eligible to enter some adult competitions. The Club also participates in a junior inter-club team competition annually.

The following are the membership categories, with maximum numbers and fees for 2010 (Juniors up to age 18/Colts 19 – 24):

Subscriptions are due and payable annually on 1st January. However, for members aged 21 years and over, payments can be spread quarterly or ten monthly (January to October inclusive) via the Direct Debit payment method. There are additional charges of £2.50 per transaction plus a premium of £10 per annum for using the Direct Debit facility. An annual EGU fee (currently £10.00 for men and £17.70 for ladies) is also payable.

Please note that any junior (age under 18) joining at the same time as a relative aged 30 or over will not be charged a subscription for the remainder of 2010. The Entrance Fee and EGU fees still apply.

The Club operates a Loyalty Bar Card which affords members a 15% discount on their drinks purchases and 10% on bar food.

No fee is payable to join the waiting list and Juniors/Colts of any golfing standard are welcome to apply for membership.
